Lenape Tech 2022-2023 Student-Driver Information

To ensure the safety and security of our campus, Lenape Technical administration has developed rules and regulations for operation and parking of vehicles on school grounds. As stated in **Joint Operating Committee Policy 223**, "*the use of motor vehicles by students for travel to and from school is a privilege. Parents and students are expected to read and comply with all driving/parking/riding regulations should they elect not to use bus transportation.*" Additionally, there must be a legitimate reason for students to drive listed on application.

All parking on school grounds is by permit only. Any unauthorized/unregistered vehicle on campus shall be towed and/or detained at the owner's expense along with notification to law enforcement. Failure to comply with these regulations may forfeit any current or future parking privilege. Due to the limited parking space available, these regulations will be strictly enforced.

Parking permits are issued beginning with 12th grade drivers on a first come, first served-basis. Remaining spaces will be made available to 11th graders in a controlled manner to ensure a safe volume of traffic on campus during arrival and dismissal. Permits will begin being issued the first week of school. All 10th grade students must ride the bus.

Students may obtain an application for a parking permit from the main office. One change effective this year, upon completion and submission of the application and all required documentation, a permit will be issued for a numbered parking stall. Students will only park in their assigned space unless otherwise directed by school staff. The cost of the permit is \$25. **Drivers will enter using the gym entrance each day.**

As parking spaces become less available, students are encouraged to submit their application and documents to be placed on a waiting list. They are not to be driving/parking on campus until approval has been made.

For students needing to drive due to an appointment, interview, or other parent-verified reason, a One-Day permit may be purchased for \$1. Students will be limited to (5) One-Day permits per school year unless otherwise approved by an administrator.

Those students enrolled in an approved cooperative education (co-op) employment experience will still need to submit an application and required documentation to receive a permit. Students on co-op are given priority.

It is important that both parents and students read and understand our student-driver policy provided on the application. Your cooperation will ensure the safety and efficiency of our campus parking areas.
