

## Your safety is our priority on Picture Day

**Dear Seniors:**

I hope this email finds you well.

As a trusted school partner, our goal remains the same this year as in previous years; to ensure schools receive essential Prestige photography services and families receive this year's cherished keepsake for their collection.

In doing so, **the safety of your school community is our number one priority.** Therefore, I would like to share the following procedures we'll be implementing to uphold that priority.

- Comprehensive safety training required for Lifetouch employees
- Employees are required to check their temperature before reporting to a photography event
- Friendly, protective face masks for photographers
- Social distancing between students and photographers during photography\*
- Equipment sanitization throughout Picture Day and garment steaming between each use.
- Students are encouraged to pay online to minimize contact on Picture Day.

\*To ensure social distancing, a space measuring at least 50' x 26' with air conditioning is required. This allows us to accommodate the proper flow for check-in, garment selection, a changing area, pose selection station, photography and departure. Additionally, only confirmed appointments will be accepted at the camera; We are unable to accommodate walk-ins. Each senior will receive a pre-scheduled date/time for their session, which must be confirmed at [prestigeportraits.com](https://prestigeportraits.com). Students are encouraged and allowed to bring one person to assist them.
