### Progress Report Pick-Up Health and Safety Plan

Lenape Technical School will be hosting our Parent Progress Report Pick-Up Night on Thursday October 22<sup>nd</sup> (5:00 to 7:00 pm) and Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup> (1:00 – 2:30 pm) . To stay current with our efforts to keep all students, staff, and community members safe, we will follow guidelines provided by the Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH), the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE).

For the convenience and safety of everyone involved parents are encouraged to schedule a Virtual Parent Meeting by phone, email, or even teleconference. This option is available not just for COVID-19 related reasons, but in case travel or scheduled hours make it difficult to attend in person. See details below on how to schedule your Virtual Parent Meeting.

Due to COVID-19, only one parent/guardian per student may attend. Students should not attend with their parent. Staff will be able to help all parents/guardians find the teachers of their student.

#### Additional Safety Protocols:

- All staff and visitors will enter the school at the main entrance.
- Parents/Guardians will be screened, including temperature screening, prior to entering the school.
- Face coverings are to be worn by all faculty, staff, and parent/guardians upon entering the building and in common areas at all times according to the Department of Health mandate.
- Individuals unable to wear face coverings due to a health condition or disability should contact Mr. Gurski, Principal to set up a virtual parent meeting.
- Individuals exhibiting symptoms or who may have a family member who is quarantined, will not be permitted to attend the event.
- Parents, faculty, and staff must maintain a safe social distance of at least 6 feet apart.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided to all program and classroom areas.
