



Meridith E. Liebl Memorial Scholarship

Apollo Trust Company may provide a scholarship award in memory of its former executive vice president and director, Meridith E. Liebl, at the discretion of its executive management in an amount to be determined annually. The Meridith E. Liebl Memorial scholarship deadline is **April 30th**. The following criteria for the scholarship award is established by the Apollo Trust Company Board of Directors, subject to revision, and delegated to the bank's executive management to present:

1. The scholarship award will be presented to a graduating senior or recent graduate of Apollo-Ridge High School.
2. The scholarship award will generally be provided on a one-time basis to any individual.
3. Apollo Trust Company will provide the Apollo-Ridge High School Guidance department with an application, which must be completed by students interested in the scholarship and submitted by the stipulated deadline.
4. Applications will be evaluated by the Apollo Trust Company executive management with input from the Apollo Ridge High School Guidance department counselors.
5. Criteria for the scholarship award will be based on the following:
 - a) Student-applicants should be accepted into a four year college or university with admission offered into the respective college or university's Business College or Business Department. Verification of such acceptance shall accompany the Meridith E. Liebl Memorial scholarship application.
 - b) If the student is admitted to a specific college or university, but the practices of such are to defer admission into a specific Business College or program until the student has achieved a certain number of college credit hours, or other academic standing or qualifications, the student-applicant shall have documented their desire to study Business in their college admission application, or other similar document, which shall accompany the Meridith E. Liebl Memorial scholarship application.
 - c) The student-applicant desiring to study Business may include business disciplines such as: Accounting, Finance, Economics, Management, Marketing, Entrepreneurial Studies, or similar disciplines offered within an established Business college, school, or program.



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- d) Other considerations for the scholarship award will include: the student-applicants' record of academic achievement, prior business experience, community service, personal achievement, activities, and personal conduct record. The scholarship award is to encourage and reward the study of Business; however, other factors will be considered amongst multiple qualified student-applicants with documented intentions to study Business.

If applications from student-applicants admitted to an established four-year college program for the study of Business are limited in number or found lacking in any manner, Apollo Trust Company may in its discretion provide a scholarship award to a student-applicant accepted into a Two-year Business College, or other Business Certificate program.

- a) The scholarship will be awarded on a nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race, gender, religion, ethnicity, disability, or financial resources.
- b) Children, grandchildren and siblings of members of the Apollo Trust Company Board of Directors and executive management are ineligible for the Meridith E. Liebl Memorial scholarship award.
- c) The scholarship award will be made payable to a college or university on behalf of the student-applicant unless their tuition, room and board, and other required fees are fully paid by other scholarships and/or financial aid. Should this situation arise, the scholarship award will be paid to the student-applicant for other expenses such as books and/or transportation.
- d) If the student-applicant does not matriculate as intended as a college student intending to study Business within the subsequent academic year, the scholarship award may be provided to an alternate student-applicant, or the Apollo Trust Company may defer the scholarship award for good cause.
